

MAKE YOUR OWN LYLE!

All you need is a paper lunch bag (5" wide), some art supplies and your imagination to make your very own **Lyle the crocodile!**

You can do this project with any crafting supplies you have at home, including:

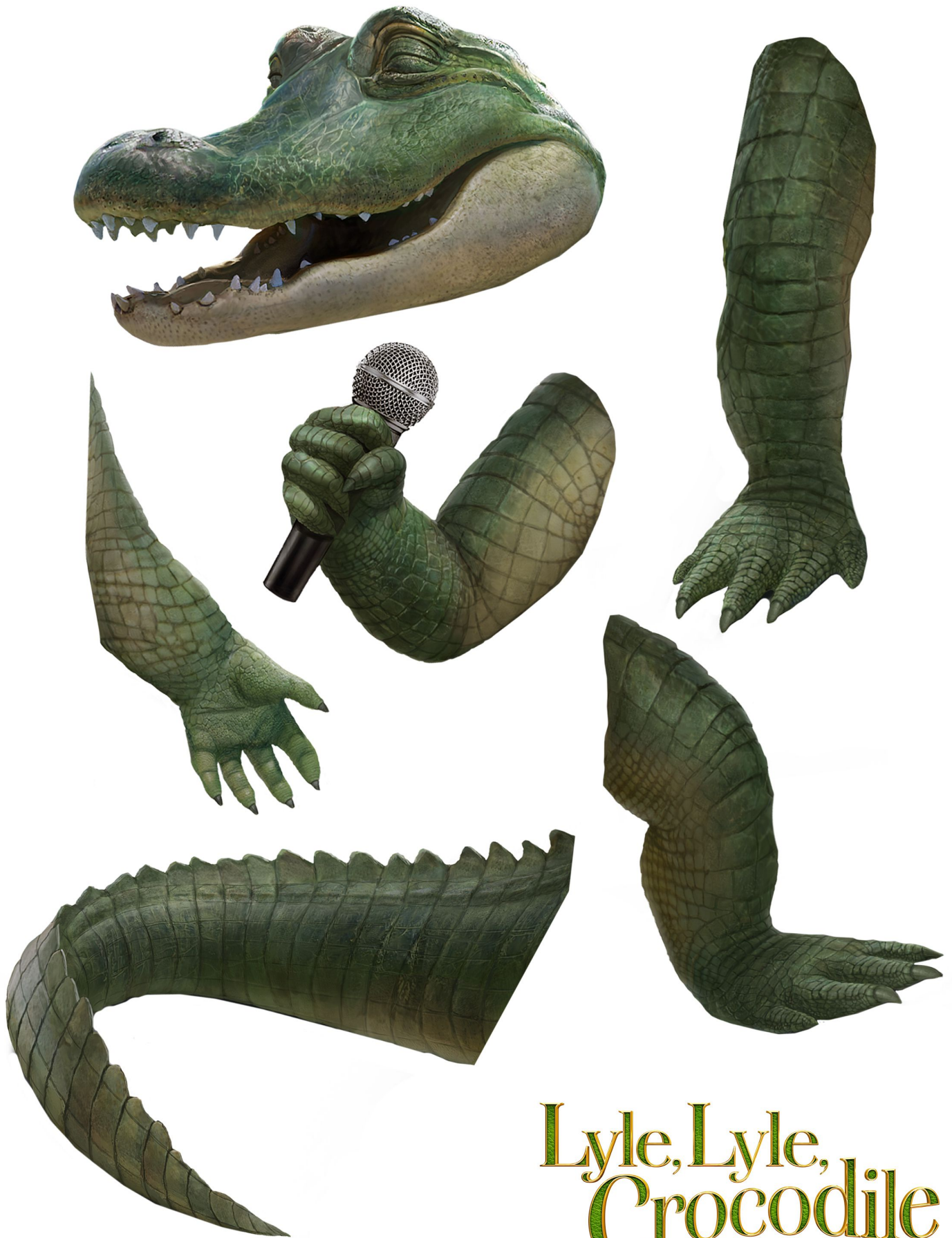
- Markers / Crayons for coloring -
- Safety Scissors -
- Red, Green & Yellow Construction Paper -
- Glue Stick -



- 1** Cut out or color a large green oval for Lyle's body and a slightly smaller, yellow oval for his belly.
- 2** Cut out Lyle's head, arms, legs and tail.
- 3** Turn your paper bag upside down so the bottom is at the top. Glue Lyle's head to the flap.
- 4** On the main part of the bag, glue down Lyle's tail, then green body and yellow belly. Then add his arms and legs.
- 5** Finish your creation off by coloring or cutting out 3 pieces of red paper (1 long, 2 short) to make his scarf!
